

PARENTS WANT CHOICE OPT-IN

12 year old student sexually assaulted

at school...during class time...in the rest room.

In the fall of 2018, we received a call from a parent distraught because her 12-year-old son was sexually abused by another boy from his class. Clearly this boy was experimenting with anal sex, considered by state educators as equal to the traditional kind. Now, the child-victim has no control over his bowels...

The principal, claiming it was consensual, did not accept responsibility and blew the parents off.

When anal sex, oral sex, and heterosexual sex is taught to students before they are mature enough to make life decisions, bad things happen!

Age appropriateness is an obvious standard and yet, the **most blatantly** violated. Who decides what is age appropriate for every child?

KINDERGARTEN: Gender identity.

THIRD Grade: Sexual Orientation.

SIXTH Grade: Contraception, Condoms, Emergency contraception.

Likely referred out or supplied by the school clinic w/o parents' knowledge or consent.

CHANGE CSE POLICY from OPT-OUT to OPT-IN

The OPT-OUT default IS NOT sufficient protection for either the safety of the student, or the rights of the parent. The default should be **NO CSE** provided to any student without prior written consent from their parent and/or guardian.

Only those students whose parents or guardians provide prior written permission to OPT-IN to CSE, should be enrolled.

Parents Rights In Education is petitioning all Oregon School Boards to change the CSE policy from OPT-OUT to OPT-IN.
